BHS CLASS OF 2021 Commencement

This year's Class of 2021 gathered for the last time on June 20 at Frontier Field for Brockport's High School Commencement ceremony.

The seniors proudly walked into the stadium to the sounds of Pomp and Circumstance, surrounded by their family and friends. After a year of hybrid/remote learning and limited gatherings, the ceremony was an emotional end to their senior year and a tribute to their time at Brockport.

Superintendent Bruno welcomed the class, "It is always an honor to celebrate such a momentous life event. As your former Hill School principal, this year has special meaning. I continue to be impressed by each of you but not surprised. Your potential stood out when you were at Hill. I look forward to the great contributions you will make to our world." Superintendent Bruno then thanked and recognized the Brockport faculty, staff and families whose dedication, support and faith brought everyone together.

Brockport's salutatorian, Nicholas Johnson, spoke of his family and the hardships they endured. He encouraged his classmates to take pride in their accomplishments and to admire the strength it took to get to graduation. "You can say it was easy, or compare your experiences to others, but at the end of the day, you did it," said Johnson. He encouraged his peers to thank those who helped them and hold on to the happy memories.

"Even though there may be some hard memories- some painful ones that stick with you- they won't break you. They will remind you of the power of the happy ones," he concluded.



Valedictorian Madison Degenfelder encouraged the Class of 2021 to be proud of their individual talents, take risks and try new things. "As we transition beyond high school and into the world, we need to remember that society cannot be comprised of only one type of person," she said. "We need people with all types of strengths and trades to follow their individual paths, but ultimately come together with our (differences) to create a comprehensive, functioning and successful society."



Principal Michael Pincelli provided traditional words of wisdom, gathered through years of experience. "If the past 15 months have taught us anything, it's that just when you think you have it all figured out, things change," he said. Pincelli encouraged the class to take risks, always do their best and to be flexible. He summarized with baseball-inspired advice. "You won't win every game. The goal is to win more than you lose. If you can do that often enough, you may find that you have won it all."

Keynote speaker and BHS math teacher, Michael Gagnier, discussed the myth of being "self-made". In this country we hear stories of people who become successful through grit and determination. Gagnier stated that no one is truly "self-made". "If you have any level of success in life, there is likely a long list of people who played a role in that success," he said. After thanking those who helped him become the teacher and person he is, he encouraged the seniors to recognize and thank those who helped and supported them. He also challenged the soon-to-be graduates to find ways to support others. "Try to live the kind of life that would have someone (someday) standing on a stage and thanking you for what you have meant to their success." He reminded everyone that we are in this together and no one can do it alone.

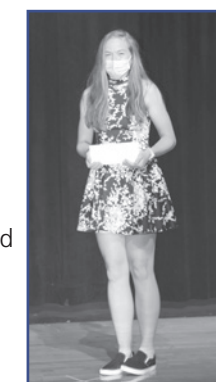
Make a Difference Scholarship (\$5,000) Antonio Collazo, Brenna Reis, Conner Roberts & Tyler Zahn

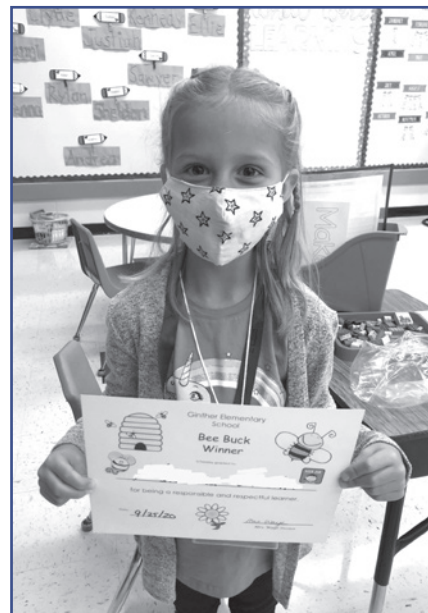


GINTHER AWARDS
